SHIPPING OF CARS TO TASSIE -- THIS IS IMPORTANT, DEADLINE IS NOW!

It is **imperative that you book NOW** for your transit on the boat. The TT Line (Spirit of Tasmania Ferry) now departs from Geelong and arrives into Devonport in Tassie. Travel from Devenport to the track is approx. 60mins.

Per the schedule detailed above, we are not on track until lunchtime on the Friday of the event. Teams can chose to either travel on the day sail on Thursday 20th or overnight sail on the same day, getting you in early Fri morning.

APS has enlisted the assistance of Rob at Trans Bass Logistics, he can organise the shipping for you but you will need to contact him directly to provide details of day(s) of travel, vehicle dimensions etc.

Freight Equalisation Scheme

There have been some questions around what compensation competitors are eligible for with respect to travel costs. At the time of writing, it is our understanding that the compensation from Tas Govt is based on competitors whom are shipping equipment (tools of trade) related to the activity (race meeting) may be eligible for reimbursement of a portion of your freight bill.
